



ScotGEM is an innovative 4 year medical degree course aimed to develop person centred doctors who are trained to work in remote and rural areas of Scotland. Students spend their 1st year in St Andrew's learning medical science, their 2nd year following 'Lifecycle Blocks' across D&G and other partner boards and their 3rd Year in GP practices across Scotland. Final year will be largely Dundee based.

This approach to medical education sees students based in a GP practice for their 3rd Year (15 in D&G 20 - 21) with their learning supported by a practice GP tutor and a regional Generalist Clinical Mentor (GCM), also a GP, who is responsible for a group of around 5 students.

There is a strong ScotGEM team across primary and secondary care in D&G that is an integral part of the national team. We have colleagues from Orkney to Newton Stewart, academic support from two highly respected universities and motivated, mature, lovely students.

Whether you want to join our ever growing team as a GP tutor or Generalist Mentor (GMC) there are plenty of opportunities to be part of a bigger team across our region and Scotland.
